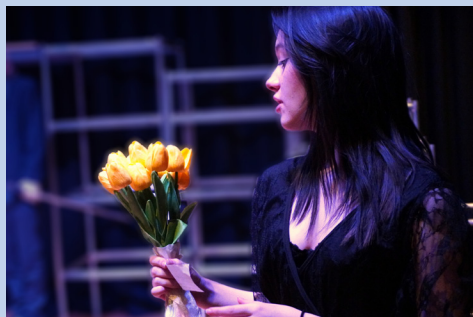
6th form students have been busy raising funds for Cancer Research UK. Raising £572 from a recent raffle, more fundraising events are planned over the coming weeks.

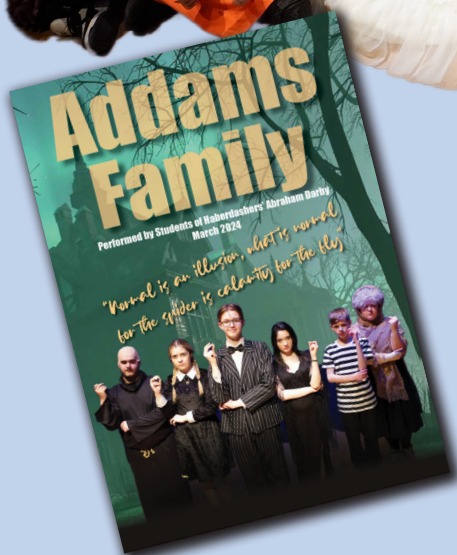
