
- 1. What is a THEME? A theme is the overarching subject to a project
- 2. What does it mean to INTERPRET? To INTERPRET means to translate an idea or theme in your own way
- 3. What is SURREALISM? An art movement based on the subconscious. Artists would be inspired by their dreams, or strange and unusual ideas.
- 4. What is RENDERING? Artwork created by combining light, shade, and a light source to create contrast. Drawing objects in 3D
- 5. What does COMPOSITION mean? To arrange and organise elements in a piece of art or music.
- 6. What is a COMPOSITE? A mixture of 2 or more pictures to make a new image. When different images are COMBINED to create a new picture.
- 7. What does METAMORPHOSIS mean? To change from 1 thing into another eg: a caterpillar changing into a butterfly.
