## What is Seneca?

Think of Seneca Learning as an online interactive revision guide. Seneca provides pupils with the knowledge they need to be successful. Seneca presents this knowledge in summaries, notes, diagrams and videos. Having presented the knowledge, Seneca then provides lots of different types of practice questions to see how well the knowledge has sunk in. The system is also completely adaptive so your child's learning experience will be tailored to suit their needs. Even better .... it's totally *free*.

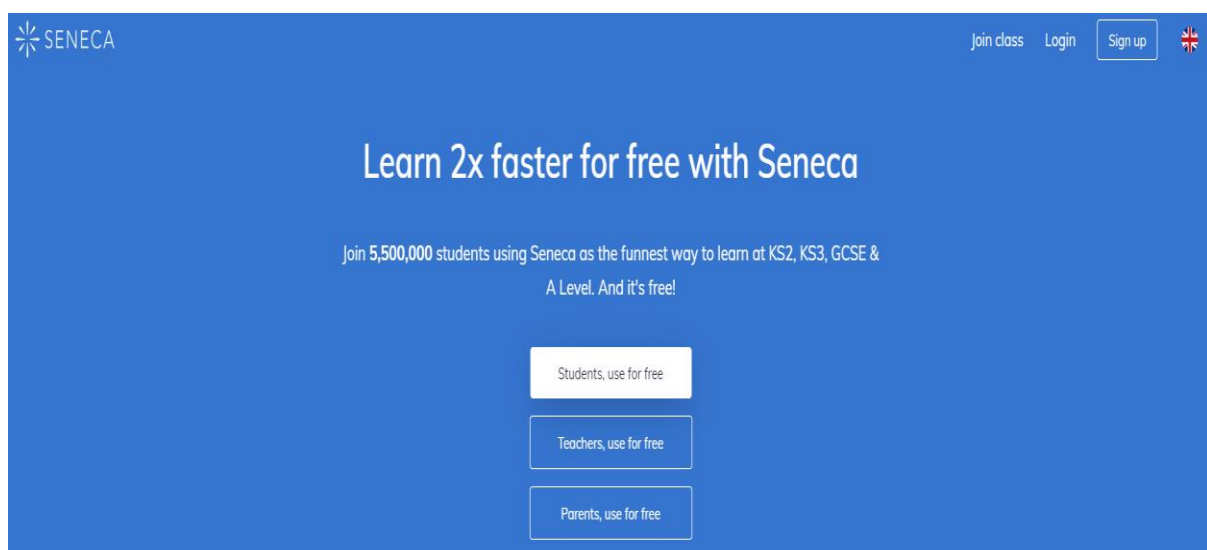
Seneca's learning materials are written by teachers and Examiners. There are courses suitable for KS3, KS4 and KS5 pupils for almost every subject. KS4 and KS5 are Exam Board specific. Ask your child to check with their teacher if they are not already using Seneca.

## How do I log in to Seneca?

Seneca is compatible with all mobile devices including mobile phones, although the content might be slightly harder to view, depending upon the screen size

Navigate to: <https://senecalearning.com/en-GB/>

Here you can either **sign up** (top right corner) if you are new to Seneca or **sign in** if your child already has an account. Tip: Encourage your child to sign up with their school email address as this follows them throughout the school.



Parents can sign up for free too, so you can see how well your child is doing (and learn some new knowledge if you want to – it might help with the homework!)

As a parent, you can easily connect to your child's account by sharing your unique link with them. This will allow you to get real-time updates of their progress across their courses, including the following statistics:

- Time spent learning
- Average score
- Sessions completed
- Correct answers

You can filter by date to see how things are changing over time. Multiple child household? No problem – you can see how they are all getting on!

### *Close those knowledge gaps caused by absence and Covid*

Worried that your child has fallen behind or has gaps in their knowledge? Use Seneca to find and close those gaps. For more advice and guidance, email your child's subject teachers. Remember, Seneca covers almost every subject, not just Maths, English & Science.

### *Homework and Revision*

Sometimes teachers will set Seneca assignments for homework or revision. However, pupils can use Seneca independently of their teachers, they can just log on and practice their knowledge. So next time they tell you they have finished all their homework, put them on Seneca and see what they know. Using Seneca for 30 minutes a day is a good habit to get pupils into, it helps them to see that revising little and often is better than cramming. Start today and help to support your child's learning.
