

## Our rewards procedures for the Academic Year 2024 - 2025

### Positive behaviour points

Every mentor time we will reward pupils wearing correct uniform and with the correct equipment with a positive behaviour point.

At the start of every lesson, pupils who arrive on time and ready to learn will be awarded an ARE (Aspiration, Respect and Excellence) point, which is worth +3. (*note: throughout the lesson staff may remove 1, 2 or all 3 of these for any pupil not displaying the behaviours expected of our Aspiration, Respect and Excellence values*).

Therefore, by doing the right thing every day your child will receive a minimum of 17 reward points every day! Plus, they have the opportunity to earn even more points – the available points can be seen in the table below:

### Daily, weekly and fortnightly rewards



Praise postcards may be awarded by any subject teacher for excellent work. Pupils will bring these home with them.



Once a fortnight every teacher will award one pupil in their class the Subject Award for great attitude and effort in class. These will appear on the Satchel One app.

### Weekly Incentive

Every week there will be a focus Achievement Point across the school. The top 3 students are rewarded with gift cards, visits to the Sixth Form Café and Queue jump passes at lunch time.



Every week there is going to be a new focus award to see who can get the most points in a specific area

- 1<sup>st</sup> - £5 Gift Card Voucher
- 2<sup>nd</sup> – Pass to visit the Sixth form Café
- 3<sup>rd</sup> – Jump the queue for one day in the restaurant with one friend
